THE SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

The American International School of Cape Town (AISCT) is a private, not-for-profit co-educational institution founded in 1997. The school educates 500 students from over 50 countries, ranging in age between 2 and 18 years and instructed by teachers from around the world. The school has an average class size of 16 students with a teacher-to-student ratio of 10:1.

AISCT is located on 24 acres in the heart of Constantia Hills with Table Mountain National Park towering in the background. Cape Town is a dynamic, modern city of 4.6 million people and is continually ranked as one of the best places to live in the world. AISCT students are able to take advantage of the numerous opportunities the city has to offer.

AISCT follows the USA curriculum and offers College Board Advanced Placement (AP) courses in the high school, including the AP Capstone Program. Following the northern hemisphere calendar, the school year begins in August and ends in June.

ACCREDITATION

AISCT is fully accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) based in California, USA, and is endorsed as an independent school by the Western Cape Education Department. AISCT is also a proud member of the Association of International Schools in Africa (AISA) and the International School Foundation (ISF).

We focus on the individual student's specific educational needs from the early years to high school and beyond.











ACADEMIC PROGRAM

Graduation requirements consist of 30 credits and the fulfillment of our service learning requirements, culminating with the Senior Impact Project, an independent research task and presentation. High School students have over 60 different courses to choose from. Upon completion of the graduation requirements, students at AISCT are awarded the USA high school diploma.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT PROGRAM

AISCT offers College Board Advanced Placement (AP) courses, including the AP Capstone program. Students can enroll in specific AP courses in grade 10 and any AP courses in grades 11 and 12, provided the prerequisites are met.

EXTRACURRICULAR PROGRAMS

AISCT offers a variety of programs in and out of school hours for its students. Students participate in competitive sports, music, drama, dance, art programs, robotics, technology, yearbook, and leadership activities such as Model United Nations (MUN). AISCT is a recognised examination center for the London Academy of Music and Dramatic Arts (LAMDA). Students who qualify for the LAMDA exams can qualify for UCAS points which can be used when applying to universities.
